ABC Codes

- Code 25607 (a) <u>CANNOT BRING ANY OTHER ALCOHOL ON THE PREMISES</u>. It is unlawful for any person or licensee to have upon any premises for which a license has been issued any alcoholic beverages other than the alcoholic beverage which the licensee is authorized to sell at the premises under his or her license.
- Code 25602 (a) <u>CANNOT FURNISH ALCOHOL TO ANY INTOXICATED PERSON.</u>
 Every person who sells, furnishes, gives, or causes to be sold, furnished, or given away, any alcoholic beverage to any habitual or common drunkard or to any obviously intoxicated person is guilty of a misdemeanor.

Furthermore, it is stated that a customer is obviously intoxicated when an average person can plainly observe that the patron is intoxicated. The usual signs are staggering, alcoholic breath, dilated pupils of the eyes, slurred speech, poor muscular coordination, etc.

- Code 25601 & 24200 <u>MUST MAINTAIN AN ORDERLY PLACE OF BUSINESS</u>.

 Every licensee or agent or employee of a licensee, who keeps, permits to be used, or suffers to be used, in conjunction with a licensed premises, any disorderly house or place in which people abide or to which people resort, to the disturbance of the neighborhood, or in which people abide or which people resort for purposes which are injurious to the public morals, health, convenience, or safety, is guilty of a misdemeanor.
- Code 25658 (a), (d) <u>CANNOT FURNISH ALCOHOL TO ANYONE UNDER 21</u>.
 Every person or licensee who sells, furnishes, gives, or causes to be sold, furnished, or given away, any alcoholic beverage to any person under the age of 21 years is guilty of a misdemeanor.
- Code 25658 (b) <u>ANYONE UNDER 21 CANNOT PURCHASE OR CONSUME ALCOHOL</u>. Any person under the age of 21 years who purchases any alcoholic beverage, or any person under the age of 21 years who consumes any alcoholic beverage in any on-sale premises, is guilty of a misdemeanor.
